

## **Mystery Fabric Challenge 2012**

### **January 19, 2012**

1. Select a minimum of 4 coordinating fabrics from your stash.
2. The smallest piece cannot be smaller than 8" by 12 or 10" square
3. The total of ALL FABRICS must total at least ONE YARD.
4. Bring all fabric in a closed container or bag and secure the top shut. (You may decorate your container if you like. Each container will be assigned a number.
5. Please include ONLY quilting cotton fabric. Fabric may be washed or unwashed.
6. You may enter AS MANY container/bags as you wish.

Those participating in the challenge will have the opportunity to bid on the bag(s) of their choice. NO peeking! We will start the bidding at \$1.00.

For the challenge, we would like each of you to use as much of the fabric you like in the quilt top. You may use one additional fabric of your choice. Please submit ONLY an unfinished quilt top (no backing or batting). Let your imagination be your guide.

Challenge quilt tops will be displayed and voted upon at the March meeting. Prizes will be awarded.

### **BONUS for March Meeting. Tweener**

#### **March 15, 2012**

Please bring any unused or not wanted challenge fabric plus any additional fabric you might want to donate to the March meeting. We will divide into teams. Each team will use their challenge and donated fabric in putting together a "creative combination" of fabric to construct a quilt for our Community Outreach (formerly Charity) quilt. Each team will need at least one machine, cutting mat, rotary cutter and the usual sewing supplies. At least one or more ironing boards will be needed. Bring what you can. We are also asking you to donate any "orphan block" you may have laying around for future community Outreach projects. More on this later. . .
