



Row By Row/Month By Month
Block of the Month Mystery
October

The October blocks in this series are the 4" *Candy Corn* & the 4" *Chocolate Kisses* blocks. The instructions are given to make 1 block of each. You will need to MAKE 3 CANDY CORN, and 4 CHOCOLATE KISSES BLOCKS.

Cutting Instructions for ONE Candy Corn Block (Make 3):

Background: Cut 2 – 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Rectangles
 Cut 2 – 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" Rectangles

Orange: Cut 2 – 1 7/8" Squares, Cut once on the diagonal

Yellow: Cut 1 – 2 1/4" Square, Cut twice on the diagonals

White: Cut 1 – 2 1/4" Square, Cut twice on the diagonals

Cutting Instructions for ONE Chocolate Kisses Block (Make 4):

Background: Cut 1 – 3 1/4" Square, Cut twice on the diagonals
 Cut 2 – 2 7/8" Squares, Cut once on the diagonals

Brown: Cut 1 – 3 1/4" Square, Cut twice on the diagonals

Background for Row Assembly: Cut 2 – 4 1/2" Squares

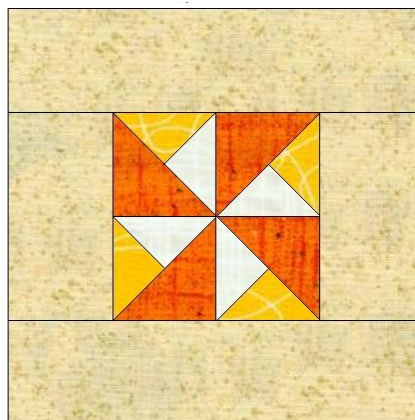
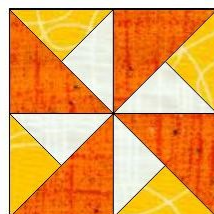
Cut 1 – 1" x 36 1/2" Strip

Assembly for One Candy Corn Block:

Just as you did in January for the Snowflake block, as shown below, create the center 4-unit section of your Candy Corn block. Your center unit should measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2". Add background rectangles as shown. Your finished block should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2". Make 3.

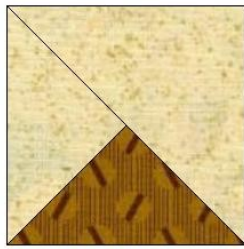

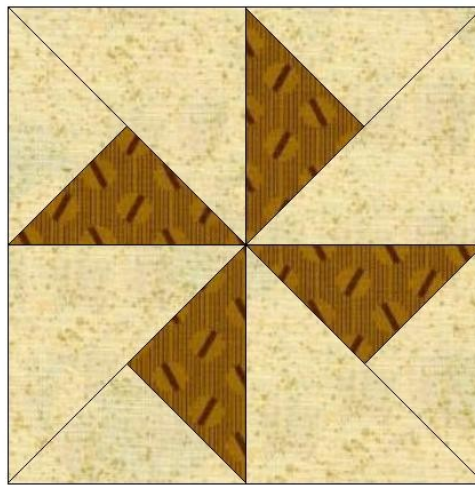


Assembly for One Chocolate Kisses Block:

Create 4 block units as shown below. Rotating as shown, join center units. Your block should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2". Make 4.

Row Assembly:

Join your blocks as shown, alternating blocks as shown. Add a 4 1/2" background square to each end. Add the 1" strip to the bottom of your row. Your row should measure 36 1/2" wide. Join to your quilt center.
