Block of the Month Mystery
November

The November block in this series is the 3" *Autumn Leaves* blocks. The instructions are given to make 1 block of each. You will need to MAKE 10 BLOCKS.

Cutting Instructions for ONE Autumn Leaves Block (Make 10):

Background: Cut 2 – 1 1/2" Squares

Cut 2 – 2" Squares, Mark on the Diagonal for HST Units

Autumn-colored Scraps: Cut 3 – 1 1/2" Squares

Cut 2 – 2" Squares for HST Units

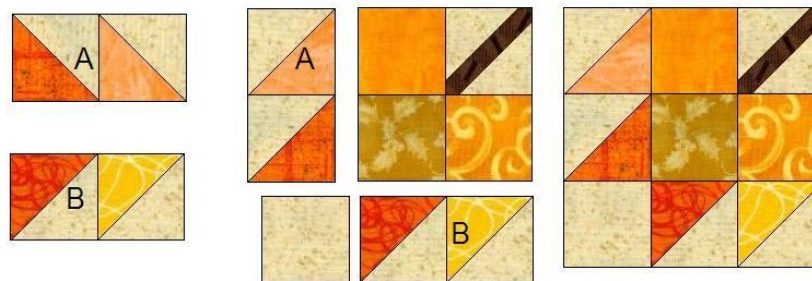
Brown Double-Fold Bias Tape (Or brown bias scraps):

Cut 1 – 2 1/2" Piece for Stem

Background for Row Setting: Cut 2 – 3 1/2" Squares.

Assembly: Make *Half-Square Triangle Units* just as you did in the May episode. Rotate and join A and B units as shown. Join 1 background square to the end of your B unit as shown. Attach the stem across the diagonal of the other background square. Join with 3 Scrap squares. Then add HST units to form your block as shown. Your block should measure 3 1/2" x 3 1/2". Make 10.

Row Assembly: Rotate half the blocks one direction and the other half in the opposite position as shown. Join blocks together. Add a 3 1/2" background square to each end of the row. Your row should measure 36 1/2" wide. Join to your quilt center.
