



Row By Row/Month By Month
Block of the Month Mystery
July

The July block in this series is the red/white/blue 5" *Twinkler* block. Note: For our Canadian friends, you can substitute a different red for the blue. You'll need to MAKE 6, using different colors for each one. (We made 3 white/blue/red and 3 white/red/blue).

Cutting Instructions for Each Block:

Background: Cut 4 – 1 1/2" Squares

Cut 4 – 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Rectangles

White: Cut 1 – 1 1/2" Square

Red: Cut 4 – 1 1/2" Squares, Mark on the Diagonal

Blue: Cut 2 – 1 1/2" Squares

Cut 2 – 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Rectangles

Background for Row Setting: Cut 2 – 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" Rectangles

Assembly:

Join 2 Blue squares to the center White square. Then join the 2 Blue rectangles as shown to form the center of your block. Using the same "quick-corner" technique as previous clues, make units as shown below using a red square on each of the background rectangles, positioning the diagonal as shown. Then join 2 units to the sides of your block center. Add 2 background squares to the ends of 2 units and join together, rotating as shown, to form your Twinkler block. Make 6 blocks. Your blocks should measure 5 1/2" x 5 1/2". Join blocks together and add background rectangles on each end to form your July row as shown. Your rows should always measure 36 1/2". Join to your Bow Tie row.
