



Row By Row/Month By Month
Block of the Month Mystery
June

The June block in this series is the 3" *Bow Tie* block for Fathers' Day. You'll need to MAKE 6, using different colors for each one.

Cutting Instructions for Each Block:

Background: Cut 2 – 2" Squares

Brown: Cut 2 – 2" Squares

Light Brown: Cut 4 – 1" Squares

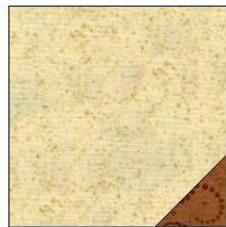
Background for Row Setting: Cut 5 – 3 1/2" squares

Cut 2 – 2" x 3 1/2" Rectangles

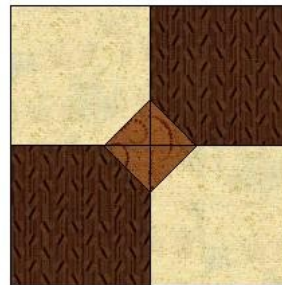
Cut 1 – 1" x 36 1/2" strip

Assembly:

Using the same "quick-corner" technique as February and March clues, make units as shown below—two using a light brown 1" square on each of the background squares and brown squares as shown. Then join the four units together, rotating as shown, to form your Bow Tie block. Make 6. Your blocks should measure 3 1/2" x 3 1/2". Join together with the five 3 1/2" background squares in-between and add rectangles on the ends to form your June row as shown. Your rows should always measure 36 1/2" in length. Sew the 1" strip to the TOP of your row. Then join to your May Flowers row.
